CHAPTER 29

SENATE BILL 1167

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 48, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 10, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 48-265; RELATING TO SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICT CREATION AND BOUNDARY CHANGES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 48, chapter 1, article 10, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 48-265, to read:

4 48-265. Petitions; form; verification of signatures

5 A. A PETITION SUBMITTED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE IN A FORM
6 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE FORM REQUIRED BY SECTIONS 19-101, 19-112 AND
7 19-121 AND SHALL CONTAIN A HEADING THAT CLEARLY IDENTIFIES THE TYPE OF
8 PETITION CIRCULATED AND A STATEMENT THAT CLEARLY DESCRIBES THE TYPE OF ACTION
9 BEING PROPOSED.

10 B. THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OR OTHER GOVERNING BODY OF A POLITICAL
11 SUBDIVISION THAT RECEIVES A PETITION PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE SHALL SUBMIT
12 A FACSIMILE COPY OF THE SIGNATURE SHEETS TO THE COUNTY RECORDER FOR
13 VERIFICATION. THE COUNTY RECORDER SHALL CONDUCT A SIGNATURE VERIFICATION THAT
14 IS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE VERIFICATION REQUIRED BY TITLE 19, CHAPTER
15 1. IF THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF SIGNATURES REQUIRED IS FEWER THAN TWO HUNDRED,
16 THE COUNTY RECORDER MAY FOLLOW EITHER A VERIFICATION PROCEDURE THAT IS
17 SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE VERIFICATION PROCEDURE PRESCRIBED BY TITLE 19,
18 CHAPTER 1 OR A VERIFICATION PROCEDURE THAT IS SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO THE
19 VERIFICATION PROCEDURE PRESCRIBED BY SECTION 19-208.02. THE COUNTY RECORDER
20 SHALL REPORT THE RESULT OF THE VERIFICATION TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OR

1 OTHER GOVERNING BODY WITHIN TEN DAYS, EXCLUDING SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS AND OTHER
2 LEGAL HOLIDAYS, AFTER RECEIVING THE FACSIMILE COPY OF THE SIGNATURE SHEETS.
3 C. IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REASON FOR DISQUALIFICATION, THE COUNTY
4 RECORDER SHALL DISQUALIFY THE SIGNATURES OBTAINED BY A PETITION CIRCULATOR
5 WHO WAS NOT A REGISTERED VOTER.
