CHAPTER 290

SENATE BILL 1389

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-2996.27, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3006.01; RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Repeal

Section 41-2996.27, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding section 41-3006.01, to read:

GNL 41-3006.01. Department of economic security; termination July 1, 2006

A. THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2006.

B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 14 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2007.

h Sec. 3. Performance audit; division of developmental disabilities

By July 31, 2001, the office of the auditor general shall:

1. Complete a comprehensive performance audit of the division of developmental disabilities in the department of economic security.

2. Submit a report of its findings to the governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives.

Sec. 4. Performance audit; division of child support enforcement

By July 31, 1999, the office of the auditor general shall:

1. Complete a performance audit of the division of child support enforcement. The audit shall review the following:

- 1 (a) Customer service operations.
- 2 (b) Privatization efforts.
- 3 (c) Debt calculation errors.
- 4 (d) Arizona tracking location automated system operations.
- 5 (e) Effectiveness of division operations.

6 2. Submit a report of its findings to the governor, the president of
 7 the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives.

8 Sec. 5. Purpose

9 The purpose of the department of economic security is to provide social
 10 services, welfare programs, vocational rehabilitation and employment services
 11 and mental retardation and other developmental disability programs.

12 Sec. 6. Department of economic security; fee schedule

13 A. For purposes of developing a fee schedule and revising the services
 14 subject to financial contributions pursuant to section 36-562, Arizona
 15 Revised Statutes, the department of economic security shall be exempt from
 16 title 41, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes.

17 B. On or before September 30, 1996, the department of economic
 18 security shall institute the formal rulemaking process required by title 41,
 19 chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, for the revision of the fee schedule and
 20 services subject to financial contributions.

21 Sec. 7. Developmental disabilities funds; deposit

22 Notwithstanding section 36-562, subsection H, Arizona Revised Statutes,
 23 all fees collected pursuant to section 36-562, Arizona Revised Statutes,
 24 shall be deposited in the department's division of developmental disabilities
 25 account pursuant to section 36-571, Arizona Revised Statutes, to offset the
 26 costs for those services.

27 Sec. 8. Department of economic security; fee schedule; report

28 The department of economic security shall submit a report to the joint
 29 legislative budget committee on or before January 31, 1997 on the status of
 30 the collections from the fee schedule for services implemented by the
 31 division of developmental disabilities.

32 Sec. 9. Retroactivity

33 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
 34 1996.

35 Sec. 10. Delayed repeal

36 Section 3 of this act is repealed from and after December 31, 2001.

37 Sec. 11. Delayed repeal

38 Section 4 of this act is repealed from and after December 31, 1999.

39 Sec. 12. Delayed repeal

40 Section 6 of this act is repealed on December 31, 1997.

41 Sec. 13. Delayed repeal

42 Section 8 of this act is repealed on March 31, 1997.
