CHAPTER 312

SENATE BILL 1060

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR DEPARTMENTS AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OF THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Appropriations; purpose; exemption

A. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 1996-1997 to the division of emergency management of the department of emergency and military affairs for deposit in the Clifton flood control project fund for use by the division in completion of the Clifton flood control project.

B. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 1997-1998 to the division of emergency management of the department of emergency and military affairs for deposit in the Clifton flood control project fund for use by the division in completion of the Clifton flood control project.

C. The appropriations made in subsections A and B of this section are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations except that all monies in the Clifton flood control project fund remaining unexpended or unencumbered after completion of the project shall revert to the state general fund.

Sec. 2. Appropriation; purpose

The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 1996-1997 to the following counties in the indicated amounts to provide temporary financial assistance in meeting required financial contributions to the Arizona long-term care system:

6 Sec. 3. Appropriation; purpose

7 The sum of \$250,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 1996-1997 from the
8 emergency medical services operating fund established by section 36-2218,
9 Arizona Revised Statutes, to the department of health services for the
10 purpose of the statewide trauma advisory board established in section
11 36-2222, Arizona Revised Statutes, for operating expenses of the board.

12 Sec. 4. Appropriation; dangerous plants, pests and diseases fund

13 Monies in the dangerous plants, pests and diseases fund established by
14 section 3-214.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the Arizona
15 department of agriculture for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to carry out the
16 provisions of title 3, chapter 2, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes.

17 Sec. 5. Appropriation; seed law fund

18 Monies in the seed law fund established by section 3-234, Arizona
19 Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the Arizona department of agriculture
20 for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to carry out the provisions of title 3, chapter
21 2, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes.

22 Sec. 6. Appropriation; organic food certification fund

23 Monies in the organic food certification fund established by section
24 3-306, Arizona Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the Arizona department
25 of agriculture for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to administer the provisions of
26 title 3, chapter 2, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes.

27 Sec. 7. Appropriation; Arizona protected native plant fund

28 All monies in the Arizona protected native plant fund established by
29 section 3-913, Arizona Revised Statutes, except for monies required to be
30 deposited in the state general fund, are appropriated to the Arizona
31 department of agriculture for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to administer and
32 enforce title 3, chapter 7, Arizona Revised Statutes.

33 Sec. 8. Appropriation; seizure fund

34 Monies in the seizure fund established by section 3-1377, Arizona
35 Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the Arizona department of agriculture
36 for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to enforce any of the provisions of title 3,
37 Arizona Revised Statutes.

38 Sec. 9. Appropriation; equine maintenance fund

39 Monies in the equine maintenance fund established by section 3-1721,
40 Arizona Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the Arizona department of
41 agriculture for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to reimburse the department for
42 expenses incurred in the handling, feeding, care and auctioning of equines
43 seized pursuant to section 3-1721, Arizona Revised Statutes.

1 Sec. 10. Appropriation: special administration fund
2 Monies in the special administration fund established by section
3 23-705, Arizona Revised Statutes, are appropriated to the commission for the
4 1996-1997 fiscal year for expenditures in accordance with the provisions of
5 sections 23-705 and 23-706, Arizona Revised Statutes.
