CHAPTER 73

SENATE BILL 1366

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 35-193.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 35-193.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 35-193.01. Office for excellence in government fund;
5 appropriation; payments; reversion

6 A. An office for excellence in government fund is established in the
7 state treasury consisting of monies paid to the office from state agencies
8 pursuant to subsection ~~D~~ C of this section. The office for excellence in
9 government established by governor's executive order shall administer the
10 fund. The services covered by this fund include training programs,
11 institutional materials and other administrative or management services.

12 B. ~~Beginning with fiscal year 1995-1996,~~ The monies in the fund are
13 subject to annual legislative appropriation.

14 C. ~~Notwithstanding section 35-190, all unexpended and unencumbered~~
15 ~~monies in the office for excellence in government fund at the end of each~~
16 ~~fiscal year revert to the state agency fund from which the monies came.~~

17 ~~D~~ C. The director of the office for excellence in government shall
18 establish procedures regarding the time and manner in which payments are made
19 into the fund by the state agencies.

20 D. AMOUNTS OF MORE THAN FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS IN THE OFFICE FOR
21 EXCELLENCE IN GOVERNMENT FUND AT THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR REVERT TO THE
22 STATE GENERAL FUND.
