CHAPTER 298

HOUSE BILL 2216

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR LIBRARY FACILITIES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; library grants-in-aid; conditions;
3 exemption

4 A. In addition to the appropriation made by Laws 1999, first special
5 session, chapter 1, section 57, the sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the
6 state general fund in fiscal year 2000-2001 to the department of library,
7 archives and public records for library grants-in-aid for the following
8 purposes in accordance with rules and regulations established by the director
9 of the department of library, archives and public records:

10 1. General grants-in-aid, two-thirds of which shall be used for urban
11 area libraries and one-third of which shall be used for rural libraries.
12 Monies shall be used for resource sharing, reading programs, training,
13 continuing education and other statewide library development programs.

14 2. Grants for new or renovation construction of facilities including
15 disabilities and wiring compliance. These monies shall be made available
16 only on a dollar for dollar matching basis from the local community.

17 3. General grants-in-aid for tribal libraries for archival, library
18 and curatorial tribal functions for the twenty-one recognized tribes and in
19 amounts based on need and tribal population as determined by the director of
20 the department of library, archives and public records in consultation with
21 the tribes and local library systems.

22 B. Grants-in-aid pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be
23 awarded to libraries that:

24 1. Are free lenders and borrowers in the interlibrary loan service.

25 2. Expend the full amount of grants-in-aid in the fiscal year for
26 which the grant is awarded.

27 3. Do not substitute state money for local funding.

28 4. File annual reports with the department of library, archives and
29 public records as requested.

30 C. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt
31 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, except that
32 all monies remaining that have not been granted by July 1, 2002 revert to the
33 state general fund.
