SENATE BILL 1250

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 17-273, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2000, CHAPTER 167, SECTION 1; REPEALING SECTION 17-273, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2000, CHAPTER 375, SECTION 1; RELATING TO THE FIREARMS SAFETY AND RANGES FUND.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 17-273, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by
3 Laws 2000, chapter 167, section 1, is amended to read:

4 17-273. Firearms safety and ranges fund; uses; criteria

5 A. The firearms safety and ranges fund is established consisting of
6 monies transferred to the fund pursuant to section 42-5029, subsection D,
7 paragraph 4, subdivision (e) AND REVENUES DERIVED FROM THE SALE OR LEASE OF
8 REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE COMMISSION AND ACQUIRED FOR OR USED FOR THE
9 PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PUBLIC SHOOTING RANGES. The Arizona game and fish
10 commission shall administer the fund which is continuously appropriated.
11 Monies in the fund are exempt from the provisions of section 35-190 relating
12 to lapsing of appropriations. Interest earned on monies in the fund shall
13 be credited to the fund.

14 B. The Arizona game and fish commission shall use monies in the fund
15 ~~to award grants to eligible applicants, based on recommendations of the~~
16 ~~advisory board under subsection C of this section, ON SHOOTING RANGES OPEN~~
17 ~~TO THE PUBLIC AND OPERATED BY GOVERNMENT OR NONPROFIT ENTITIES for the~~
18 following purposes:

- 19 1. Shooting range engineering and studies.
- 20 2. Noise abatement.
- 21 3. Safety enhancement.
- 22 4. Shooting range design.
- 23 5. New shooting range SITES AND construction.
- 24 6. Shooting range relocation.
- 25 7. Other projects that are necessary to operate AND MAINTAIN a
26 shooting range under good practices and management.

27 ~~C. A shooting range project advisory board is established consisting~~
28 ~~of two members appointed by the president of the senate, two members~~
29 ~~appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and one employee of~~
30 ~~the department, appointed by the commission, whose employment assignment~~
31 ~~includes shooting range projects. The members serve at the pleasure of the~~
32 ~~president of the senate, speaker of the house of representatives or the~~
33 ~~commission, respectively. The board shall:~~

- 34 ~~1. Develop the application, evaluation and award procedures for~~
