AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 37; RELATING TO STATE INTERNET WEB SITES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding
3 chapter 37, to read:

4 CHAPTER 37

5 ACCESS TO STATE AGENCY WEB SITE RECORDS AND PRIVACY

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 41-3901. Definitions

8 IN THIS CHAPTER, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

9 1. "AGENCY":

10 (a) MEANS ANY BOARD, COMMISSION, DEPARTMENT OR OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE
11 UNIT OF THIS STATE ESTABLISHED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA OR BY ENACTMENT
12 OF THE LEGISLATURE.

13 (b) INCLUDES THE LEGISLATURE, THE COURTS AND THE GOVERNOR.

14 2. "AGENCY WEB SITE" MEANS AN AGENCY OWNED, OPERATED OR FUNDED WEB
15 SITE CONNECTED TO THE INTERNET AND INCLUDES WEB SITES ACCESSED THROUGH THE
16 "ARIZONA@YOURSERVICE" PORTAL.

17 3. "PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT" MEANS A DESCRIPTION OF AN AGENCY'S
18 INFORMATION PRACTICES.

19 41-3902. Obligations of state agencies obtaining information on
20 line

21 AN AGENCY WEB SITE PROVIDED BY THIS STATE SHALL CONTAIN A PRIVACY
22 POLICY STATEMENT TO DISCLOSE THE INFORMATION GATHERING AND DISSEMINATION
23 PRACTICES RELATED TO THE INTERNET. THE PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT SHALL
24 DESCRIBE AT A MINIMUM THE AGENCY'S INFORMATION PRACTICES WITH REGARD TO THE
25 FOLLOWING MATTERS:

26 1. WHAT SERVICES THE SITE PROVIDES.

27 2. THE INFORMATION THE AGENCY OBTAINS FROM INDIVIDUALS ON LINE.

28 3. A PERSON'S OPTION TO CHOOSE TO PROCEED WITH THE TRANSACTION AND ANY
29 ALTERNATIVES AVAILABLE.

30 4. HOW THE AGENCY USES THE INFORMATION.

31 5. WHETHER AND UNDER WHAT CIRCUMSTANCES THE AGENCY DISCLOSES THE
32 OBTAINED INFORMATION TO OTHER ENTITIES OR PERSONS.

33 6. WHETHER OTHER ENTITIES OR PERSONS ARE COLLECTING INFORMATION
34 THROUGH THE AGENCY WEB SITE.

35 7. A GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE SECURITY MEASURES IN PLACE TO PROTECT
36 A PERSON'S INFORMATION WITHOUT COMPROMISING THE INTEGRITY OF THE SECURITY
37 MEASURES.






