CHAPTER 272

SENATE BILL 1104

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY FOR THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK PROGRAM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
4 fiscal year 2002-2003 to the department of environmental quality for deposit
5 in the underground storage tank revolving fund assurance account, area A,
6 established by section 49-1015, Arizona Revised Statutes, to be used only for
7 the purpose of paying claims for partial coverage of corrective actions costs
8 incurred pursuant to section 49-1052, Arizona Revised Statutes. The
9 appropriation made pursuant to this subsection shall not be used for any
10 administrative costs.

11 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
13 lapsing of appropriations, except that monies remaining unexpended and
14 unencumbered on June 30, 2004 revert to the state general fund.
