CHAPTER 295

SENATE BILL 1573

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 36-699 AND 36-700; RELATING TO MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 6, article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding sections 36-699 and 36-700, to read:

4 36-699. Folic acid supplements; distribution; counseling;
5 funding

6 A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO DISTRIBUTE FOLIC ACID
7 SUPPLEMENTS TO WOMEN OF CHILDBEARING AGE AND TO PROVIDE THEM WITH COUNSELING
8 AND INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROPER USE OF THE SUPPLEMENTS.

9 B. LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE SUPPLEMENTS AND
10 PROVIDE THE COUNSELING AND INFORMATION SERVICES.

11 C. TO DISTRIBUTE THE SUPPLEMENTS AND PROVIDE THE COUNSELING AS
12 PRESCRIBED BY THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE MONIES APPROPRIATED BY THE
13 LEGISLATURE FOR THE FEDERAL WOMEN, INFANTS AND CHILDREN FOOD PROGRAM.

14 36-700. Farmers' market nutrition program

15 A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM
16 AND APPLY TO RECEIVE FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS UNDER THE FEDERAL FARMERS' MARKET
17 NUTRITION ACT OF 1992.

18 B. TO PROVIDE THE LOCAL FUNDS FOR THE FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION
19 PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE MONIES APPROPRIATED FOR THE FEDERAL WOMEN,
20 INFANTS AND CHILDREN FOOD PROGRAM.




