AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 29, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-2901.03; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 29, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 36-2901.03, to read:
4 36-2901.03. Breast and cervical cancer treatment; additional
5 definition of eligibility
6 A. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS ARTICLE, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2002,
7 ELIGIBLE PERSON INCLUDES A PERSON WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
8 REQUIREMENTS:
9 1. HAS BEEN SCREENED FOR BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER THROUGH THE WELL
10 WOMAN HEALTHCHECK PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES.
11 2. NEEDS TREATMENT FOR BREAST OR CERVICAL CANCER.
12 3. IS UNDER SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.
13 4. IS NOT OTHERWISE COVERED UNDER CREDITABLE COVERAGE AS DEFINED IN
14 SECTION 2701(c) OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES ACT (42 UNITED STATES CODE
15 SECTION 300gg(c)).
16 B. THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL LIMIT THE ASSISTANCE IT PROVIDES PURSUANT
17 TO THIS SECTION TO MEDICALLY NECESSARY SERVICES PROVIDED DURING THE PERIOD
18 THAT THE PERSON REQUIRES TREATMENT FOR BREAST OR CERVICAL CANCER AS
19 DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.
20 C. THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL USE A SIMPLIFIED ELIGIBILITY FORM THAT THE
21 APPLICANT MAY MAIL TO THE ADMINISTRATION. ONCE THE ADMINISTRATION RECEIVES
22 A COMPLETED APPLICATION THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL EXPEDITE THE ELIGIBILITY
23 DETERMINATION AND ENROLLMENT ON A PROSPECTIVE BASIS.
24 Sec. 2. Appropriations; administrative costs; exemption
25 A. The sum of \$1,300,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2001-2002 and
26 \$1,400,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2002-2003 from the state general
27 fund to the Arizona health care cost containment system for the purposes of
28 this act.
29 B. The administration may not spend more than five per cent of the
30 monies appropriated in subsection A of this section for administrative costs.
31 C. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt
32 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
33 lapsing of appropriations.
