HOUSE BILL 2541

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-1511; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3011.01; RELATING TO THE STATE ENERGY CODE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 10, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 41-1511, to read:

4 41-1511. State energy code; advisory commission

5 A. THE ENERGY CODE THAT IS DRAFTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
6 ENERGY OFFICE AND THAT IS BASED ON THE 2000 INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION
7 CODE FOR RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION AND THE AMERICAN SOCIETY OF HEATING,
8 REFRIGERATING AND AIR CONDITIONING ENGINEERS ENERGY STANDARD FOR BUILDINGS
9 EXCEPT LOW-RISE RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS (ASHRAE/IESNA STANDARD 90.1-1999) FOR
10 COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION IS RECOGNIZED AS THE VOLUNTARY STATE ENERGY CODE.
11 THIS CODE SHALL ALSO BE REFERENCED FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING POLICYMAKERS
12 IN THIS STATE TO PROVIDE INCENTIVES FOR THE USE OF ENERGY SAVING DEVICES AND
13 METHODS.

14 B. A STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION IS ESTABLISHED CONSISTING
15 OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

16 1. A REPRESENTATIVE OF AN AGRICULTURAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THAT
17 PROVIDES ELECTRIC POWER IN THIS STATE WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

18 2. A REPRESENTATIVE OF A PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION THAT PROVIDES
19 ELECTRIC POWER IN THIS STATE WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

20 3. A REPRESENTATIVE OF A PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION THAT PROVIDES
21 NATURAL GAS SERVICES IN THIS STATE WHO IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

22 4. FOUR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE
23 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, ONE OF WHOM IS AN EXPERT IN ENERGY SAVINGS OR
24 IMPROVED TECHNOLOGY IN RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, ONE OF WHOM IS
25 A REPRESENTATIVE OF ORGANIZED LABOR WHO HAS BEEN CERTIFIED AS A JOURNEYMAN
26 ELECTRICIAN FOR RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL ELECTRICAL WORK AND NO MORE THAN
27 TWO OF WHOM ARE MEMBERS OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY.

28 5. FOUR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO ARE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF
29 THE SENATE, ONE OF WHOM IS A PERSON WHO HOLDS A VALID ARIZONA LICENSE AS A
30 RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR AND NO MORE THAN TWO OF WHOM
31 ARE MEMBERS OF THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY.

32 6. TWO MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE HOMEBUILDING INDUSTRY, ONE OF WHOM IS
33 APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND ONE OF WHOM IS
34 APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

35 C. THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION SHALL
36 SERVE THREE YEAR TERMS AND SHALL ANNUALLY ELECT ONE OF ITS MEMBERS TO SERVE
37 AS CHAIRPERSON.

38 D. MEMBERS OF THE STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION ARE NOT
39 ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE COMPENSATION BUT ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT
40 OF EXPENSES PURSUANT TO TITLE 38, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 2.

41 E. THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ENERGY OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE STAFF
42 SUPPORT TO THE STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION.

1 F. THE STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION SHALL: .

2 1. REVIEW AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE STATE ENERGY CODE,
3 INCLUDING ANY CHANGES TO THE STATE ENERGY CODE. THE COMMISSION SHALL USE AN
4 OPEN, VOLUNTARY AND CONSENSUS PROCESS TO REVIEW THE STATE ENERGY CODE.

5 2. PERFORM COST BENEFIT ANALYSES OF POTENTIAL STATE INCENTIVES FOR THE
6 USE OF ENERGY SAVING DEVICES AND METHODS.

7 3. ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, SUBMIT TO THE GOVERNOR, THE
8 PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
9 DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OR ITS SUCCESSOR, THE CHAIRPERSON OF
10 THE SENATE GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE OR ITS SUCCESSOR COMMITTEE, THE CHAIRPERSON
11 OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY UTILITIES AND TECHNOLOGY OR ITS SUCCESSOR
12 COMMITTEE AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE ARIZONA STATE LIBRARY, ARCHIVES AND PUBLIC
13 RECORDS AN ANNUAL REPORT THAT SHALL CONTAIN A REVIEW OF AND RECOMMENDATIONS
14 REGARDING THE STATE ENERGY CODE.

15 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
16 amended by adding section 41-3011.01, to read:

17 41-3011.01. State energy code advisory commission; termination
18 July 1, 2011

19 A. THE STATE ENERGY CODE ADVISORY COMMISSION TERMINATES ON JULY 1,
20 2011.

21 B. SECTION 41-1511 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2012.

22 Sec. 3. Purpose

23 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection E, Arizona Revised Statutes,
24 the purpose of the state energy code advisory commission is to review and
25 make recommendations regarding the state energy code.

26 Sec. 4. Initial terms of members of the state energy code
27 advisory commission

28 A. Notwithstanding section 41-1511, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added
29 by this act, the initial terms of members are:

- 30 1. Four terms ending January 1, 2003.
31 2. Four terms ending January 1, 2004.
32 3. Five terms ending January 1, 2005.

33 B. The appointing authority shall make all subsequent appointments as
34 prescribed by statute.


