# HOUSE BILL 2354

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-176; RELATING TO THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND SETTLEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 1, article 4, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 41-176, to read:

4 41-176. County Navajo-Hopi land dispute settlement fund;  
5 investment; distribution; exemption

6 A. A COUNTY NAVAJO-HOPI LAND DISPUTE SETTLEMENT FUND IS ESTABLISHED  
7 CONSISTING OF THE MONIES RECEIVED BY THIS STATE FROM THE UNITED STATES AS A  
8 RESULT OF THE NAVAJO-HOPI LAND DISPUTE SETTLEMENT ACT OF 1996 (25 UNITED  
9 STATES CODE SECTION 640(d)-note).

10 B. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND AS A CONTINUING  
11 APPROPRIATION AND SHALL INVEST AND DIVEST MONIES IN THE FUND AS PROVIDED BY  
12 SECTION 35-313, AND MONIES EARNED FROM INVESTMENT SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE  
13 FUND.

14 C. IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COUNTIES, EACH YEAR THE STATE TREASURER  
15 SHALL PAY TO EACH COUNTY A SHARE OF THE FUND MONIES EARNED FROM INVESTMENT  
16 BASED ON THE PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL LAND IN EACH COUNTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE  
17 HOPI TRIBE THAT IS REMOVED FROM THE COUNTY TAX ROLLS AS A RESULT OF THE  
18 NAVAJO-HOPI LAND DISPUTE SETTLEMENT ACT OF 1996 (25 UNITED STATES CODE  
19 SECTION 640(d)-note).

20 D. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190  
21 RELATING TO LAPSING OF APPROPRIATIONS.

22 Sec. 2. Emergency

23 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
24 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
25 law.
