AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 4.1, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 41-860; RELATING TO STATE EMBLEMS.

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 4.1, article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 41-860, to read:
4 41-860. State butterfly
5 A. THE PAPILIONIDAE PAPILIO MULTICAUDATA, TWO-TAILED SWALLOWTAIL IS
6 THE OFFICIAL STATE BUTTERFLY.
7 B. DESIGNATION OF THE STATE BUTTERFLY PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL
8 NOT CONSTITUTE GROUNDS FOR PROTECTION OF THE BUTTERFLY OR ITS HABITAT.
