CHAPTER 55

HOUSE BILL 2394

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-173, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SPECIAL OLYMPICS ARIZONA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-173, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-173. Special olympics tax refund fund

5 A. The special olympics tax refund fund is established consisting of
6 contributions to the ~~Arizona special olympics~~ SPECIAL OLYMPICS ARIZONA AS A
7 CORPORATION from income tax refunds collected pursuant to section 43-614,
8 other unrestricted private gifts and grants and investment earnings. No
9 public monies may be appropriated to or designated for this fund.

10 B. The fund shall be administered by the department of revenue. On
11 notice from the director, the state treasurer shall invest and divest monies
12 in the fund as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned from investment
13 shall be credited to the fund.

14 C. Before December 31 each year the department of revenue shall
15 determine the cost of administering the special olympics income tax refund
16 checkoff under section 43-614 and this section and shall deduct this amount
17 from monies otherwise distributable to the ~~Arizona special olympics~~ SPECIAL
18 OLYMPICS ARIZONA AS A CORPORATION. The deducted monies shall be deposited,
19 pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147, in the state general fund. If the
20 amount to be deducted for administrative cost exceeds the amount
21 distributable, the excess deduction shall be carried forward as a liability
22 to the ~~special olympics~~ SPECIAL OLYMPICS ARIZONA AS A CORPORATION until
23 paid. On May 15 and October 15 each year the department of revenue shall
24 distribute all monies in the fund not necessary for administrative costs to
25 the department of economic security to be used only to contract with a
26 ~~nonprofit entity~~ THE SPECIAL OLYMPICS ARIZONA AS A CORPORATION for delivery
27 of those services essential to programs of the ~~Arizona special olympics~~
28 SPECIAL OLYMPICS ARIZONA AS A CORPORATION or its successor for the citizens
29 of Arizona with mental retardation, including coordination and development
30 of such programs within this state.

31 D. Monies contributed or accruing to the fund are not state revenues
32 for purposes of any constitutional limitation or prohibition and are exempt
33 from lapsing under section 35-190.
