# HOUSE BILL 2050

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-766.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-766.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 38-766.01. Retired members; return to work

5 A. Notwithstanding section 38-766, a retired member may return to work  
6 and still be eligible to receive retirement benefits if all of the following  
7 requirements are satisfied:

8 1. The retired member has attained the member's normal retirement age.

9 2. The retired member terminated employment at least twelve months  
10 before returning to work.

11 3. IF THE RETIRED MEMBER RETURNS TO WORK AS A TEACHER, the retired  
12 member is working as a certificated teacher.

13 4. IF THE RETIRED MEMBER RETURNS TO WORK AS A TEACHER, the retired  
14 member's employment is not subject to the requirements prescribed in sections  
15 15-538, 15-538.01 and 15-539 through 15-543.

16 5. The retired member acknowledges in writing the provisions of this  
17 section.

18 B. An employer of a retired member who returns to work pursuant to  
19 this section shall not pay contributions on behalf of the retired member  
20 pursuant to section 38-736, 38-737 or 38-797.05. A retired member who  
21 returns to work pursuant to this section does not accrue credited service,  
22 retirement benefits or long-term disability program benefits pursuant to  
23 article 2.1 of this chapter for the period the retired member returns to  
24 work.
