CHAPTER 1

SENATE BILL 1006

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-3002.20, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3007.10; AMENDING SECTION 41-3452, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 41-3002.20, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3007.10, to read:

6 41-3007.10. Automobile theft authority; termination July 1,
7 2007

8 A. THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2007.

9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 31 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2008.

10 Sec. 3. Section 41-3452, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

11 41-3452. Automobile theft authority committee; members; duties

12 A. The automobile theft authority committee is established. The
13 committee consists of the following members:

14 1. Three members of the senate who are appointed by the president of
15 the senate, ~~who serve on the judiciary, transportation and financial~~
16 ~~institutions and retirement committees, or their successor committees,~~ and
17 not more than two of whom represent the same political party. If any member
18 is no longer in office, the president of the senate shall fill the vacancy.

19 2. Three members of the house of representatives who are appointed by
20 the speaker of the house of representatives, ~~who serve on the judiciary,~~
21 ~~transportation and banking and insurance committees, or their successor~~
22 ~~committees,~~ and not more than two of whom represent the same political party.
23 If any member is no longer in office, the speaker of the house of
24 representatives shall fill the vacancy.

25 3. The governor or the governor's designee.

26 4. The director of the department of insurance or the director's
27 designee.

28 B. The committee shall select a chairman.

29 C. The automobile theft authority committee shall review:

30 1. The automobile theft authority prevention programs and the
31 effectiveness of the programs.

32 2. The automobile theft authority funding sources and the need for
33 additional funding.

34 3. The impact of the automobile theft authority prevention programs
35 on automobile theft rates.

36 4. The impact of the automobile theft authority prevention programs
37 on motor vehicle insurance costs.

38 D. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation or
39 reimbursement of expenses for service on the automobile theft authority
40 committee.

1 Sec. 4. Purpose

2 The purpose of the automobile theft authority is to provide assistance
3 to law enforcement with funding and programs to reduce the incidence of
4 automobile theft.

5 Sec. 5. Retroactivity

6 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
7 2002.
