CHAPTER 101

SENATE BILL 1212

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 42-11152, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 42-11152, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 42-11152. Affidavit; false statements

5 A. Except as provided in sections 42-11109 and 42-11110 and except for
6 property described in sections 42-11125 and 42-11127, a person who claims
7 exemption from taxation under article IX, section 2, 2.1 or 2.2, Constitution
8 of Arizona, shall:

9 1. When initially claiming the exemption, appear before the county
10 assessor to make an affidavit as to the person's eligibility. IF A PERSONAL
11 APPEARANCE BEFORE THE COUNTY ASSESSOR WOULD CREATE A SEVERE HARDSHIP, THE
12 COUNTY ASSESSOR MAY ARRANGE A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY MEETING PLACE TO MAKE AN
13 AFFIDAVIT AS TO THE PERSON'S ELIGIBILITY.

14 2. When claiming the exemption in subsequent years, appear before the
15 county assessor or a notary public to make an affidavit as to the person's
16 eligibility.

17 3. Fully answer all questions on the eligibility form or otherwise
18 required by the assessor for that purpose.

19 B. At the assessor's discretion, the assessor may require additional
20 proof of the facts stated by the person before allowing an exemption.

21 C. A person who is in the United States military service and who is
22 absent from this state or who is confined in a veterans' hospital or another
23 licensed hospital may make the required affidavit in the presence of any
24 officer who is authorized to administer oaths on a form obtained from the
25 county assessor.

26 D. A false statement that is made or sworn to in the affidavit is
27 perjury.






