CHAPTER 146

HOUSE BILL 2501

AN ACT

URGING AN EXEMPTION FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY
FOR EMISSIONS TESTING FOR MOTORCYCLES AND COLLECTIBLE VEHICLES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Request for state implementation plan exemption:
3 report

4 The department of environmental quality shall contact the United States
5 environmental protection agency and request a vehicle emissions testing
6 exemption for either motorcycles, collectible vehicles or both from the state
7 implementation or maintenance plan. The department shall make the exemption
8 request only if it determines that the continued emissions testing of either
9 motorcycles, collectible vehicles or both does not provide a significant air
10 quality benefit and is not necessary to satisfy the requirements of the state
11 implementation or maintenance plans. The department of environmental quality
12 shall submit a written report of its findings and activities regarding this
13 request to the governor, the president of the senate, the speaker of the
14 house of representatives and the Maricopa association of governments on or
15 before December 31, 2004. For purposes of this section, "collectible
16 vehicle" means a vehicle that satisfies all of the following:

17 1. Bears model year date of original manufacture that is fifteen years
18 old or older.

19 2. Is of unique or rare design, of limited production and an object
20 of curiosity.

21 3. Is maintained primarily for use in car club activities,
22 exhibitions, parades or other functions of public interest or for a private
23 collection and is used only infrequently for other purposes.

24 4. Has a collectible vehicle or classic automobile insurance coverage
25 that restricts the collectible vehicle mileage and requires the owner to have
26 another vehicle for personal use.

27 5. At the time a vehicle is registered as a collectible vehicle, the
28 department shall enter into the vehicle record the fact that the vehicle is
29 covered by collectible vehicle or classic automobile insurance. If an
30 insurer notifies the department of the cancellation or nonrenewal of the
31 insurance coverage, the department shall cancel the registration of the
32 vehicle and the vehicle's exemption from emissions inspection pursuant to
33 section 49-542, Arizona Revised Statutes, unless evidence of coverage is
34 presented to the department within sixty days.

35 Sec. 2. Repeal

36 Section 1 of this act is repealed from and after December 31, 2004.


