AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 34, CHAPTER 4, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE 1;
RELATING TO STATE BUILDINGS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 34, chapter 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding article 1, to read:

4 ARTICLE 1. STATE BUILDINGS

5 34-401. New and renovated state buildings; automated external
6 defibrillators

7 A. ANY STATE BUILDING THAT IS CONSTRUCTED OR ANY STATE BUILDING THAT
8 UNDERGOES A MAJOR RENOVATION AT A COST OF AT LEAST TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND
9 DOLLARS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH
10 AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

11 B. FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
12 JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STRATEGIC
13 PLANNING AND BUDGETING SHALL INCLUDE FUNDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF AUTOMATED
14 EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS IN CAPITAL BUDGETS FOR NEW STATE BUILDINGS.

17 effective from and after June 30, 2003.
