20 Sec. 3. Arizona housing commission; family housing allocation

22 A. The Arizona housing commission shall establish a temporary  
23 committee composed of representatives of all stakeholders in industrial  
24 development authority financing for single family and multiple family housing  
25 allocations pursuant to title 35, chapter 5, Arizona Revised Statutes.

26 B. On or before December 1, 2002, the committee shall submit a written  
27 report of its recommendations on allocations and improvements to the system  
28 to the governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of  
29 representatives and shall provide a copy of this report to the secretary of  
30 state and the director of the Arizona state library, archives and public  
31 records.
