# SENATE BILL 1372

AN ACT

TRANSFERRING MONIES FROM THE ECONOMIC STRENGTH PROJECT FUND FOR SMALL AIRPORT GRANTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Vehicle license tax; community airport grants;  
3 exemption

4 A. Notwithstanding section 28-5808, subsection A, Arizona Revised  
5 Statutes, in each month in fiscal year 2002-2003, the director of the  
6 department of transportation shall deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
7 35-147, Arizona Revised Statutes, forty-one thousand six hundred sixty-six  
8 dollars in a special account established by the department of administration  
9 for the purpose prescribed in subsection C of this section.

10 B. The monies deposited pursuant to subsection A of this section shall  
11 be from the portion of the monies distributed pursuant to section 28-5808,  
12 subsection A, Arizona Revised Statutes, that would be deposited in the  
13 economic strength project fund pursuant to section 28-6534, Arizona Revised  
14 Statutes, if distributed pursuant to statute. The deposit of these monies  
15 in the special account shall not in any way impact distributions of vehicle  
16 license tax revenues or any other revenues to cities, towns or counties  
17 pursuant to section 28-5808, Arizona Revised Statutes, or title 28, chapter  
18 18, Arizona Revised Statutes.

19 C. The department of transportation may use up to five hundred  
20 thousand dollars in the special account for grants for small community air  
21 service and airport upgrades to those communities in this state that are  
22 receiving federal monies for small community air service development pursuant  
23 to Public Law 106-181. The state transportation board shall adopt policies  
24 and procedures for awarding grants pursuant to this subsection.

25 D. The monies in the special account established pursuant to  
26 subsection A of this section are exempt from the provisions of section  
27 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to lapsing of appropriations,  
28 except that any monies remaining in the special account on June 30, 2006  
29 shall be deposited in the economic strength project fund established by  
30 section 28-7282, Arizona Revised Statutes.

31 Sec. 2. Retroactivity

32 This act is effective retroactively to from and after June 30, 2002.
