HOUSE BILL 2203

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 8-243, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO JUVENILE OFFENDERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 8-243, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 8-243. Liability of parents to bear expense; exception

5 A. The supreme court shall administer the activities, including
6 providing the cost of services, for children who are referred to the juvenile
7 court as incorrigible or delinquent and WHO are placed in foster care other
8 than in a state institution or WHO require shelter care or treatment.

9 B. If THE JUVENILE COURT AWARDS OR COMMITS a child ~~is to be awarded~~
10 ~~or committed~~ to the department of juvenile corrections or other state
11 department or institution, the juvenile court shall inquire into the ability
12 of the child, the child's estate, parent or guardian or the person who has
13 custody of the child to bear the charge, expense and maintenance including
14 the medical, dental and mental health care of the child while THE CHILD IS
15 committed to the custody of the department of juvenile corrections or other
16 public or private institution or agency, or private person or persons. If
17 the court is satisfied that the child, the child's estate, parent or guardian
18 or the person who has custody of the child can bear ~~such~~ THE charges, expense
19 and maintenance or any portion of them, the juvenile court shall fix the
20 amount thereof and direct that the child, the child's estate, parent or
21 guardian or the person who has custody of the child pay ~~such~~ THE amount
22 monthly to the department of juvenile corrections or other public or private
23 institution or agency, or private person or persons to which the child is
24 awarded or committed. The department of juvenile corrections or other public
25 or private institution or agency or private person or persons shall
26 acknowledge THE receipt of the money ~~received to the person paying the same~~
27 MONIES. The department of juvenile corrections shall retain and utilize the
28 money ~~as~~ it receives to fund work restitution programs for juveniles. Except
29 as provided in section 8-243.01, other state institutions or agencies shall
30 deposit, pursuant to sections 35-146 and 35-147, the money in the state
31 general fund. The juvenile court shall transmit a copy of its orders
32 concerning payment along with its order of commitment.

33 C. IF THE JUVENILE COURT AWARDS OR COMMITS A CHILD TO A JUVENILE
34 DETENTION FACILITY, THE JUVENILE COURT SHALL INQUIRE INTO THE ABILITY OF THE
35 CHILD, THE CHILD'S ESTATE, PARENT OR GUARDIAN OR THE PERSON WHO HAS CUSTODY
36 OF THE CHILD TO BEAR THE CHARGE, EXPENSE AND MAINTENANCE INCLUDING FOOD,
37 CLOTHING, SHELTER AND SUPERVISION OF THE CHILD WHILE THE CHILD IS DETAINED
38 IN A JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY. IF THE JUVENILE COURT IS SATISFIED THAT
39 THE CHILD, THE CHILD'S ESTATE, PARENT OR GUARDIAN OR THE PERSON WHO HAS
40 CUSTODY OF THE CHILD CAN BEAR THE CHARGES, EXPENSE AND MAINTENANCE OR ANY
41 PORTION OF THEM, THE JUVENILE COURT MAY FIX THE AMOUNT OF THE COSTS AND
42 DIRECT THAT THE CHILD, THE CHILD'S ESTATE, PARENT OR GUARDIAN OR THE PERSON
43 WHO HAS CUSTODY OF THE CHILD PAY THE AMOUNT MONTHLY TO THE JUVENILE COURT.

1 THE ASSESSMENT IS COLLECTIBLE AS A CIVIL JUDGMENT. THE JUVENILE COURT SHALL
2 ACKNOWLEDGE THE RECEIPT OF THE MONIES AND SHALL TRANSMIT THE MONIES MONTHLY
3 TO THE COUNTY TREASURER FOR DEPOSIT IN THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND. THE JUVENILE
4 COURT SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF ITS ORDERS CONCERNING PAYMENT ALONG WITH ITS
5 ORDER OF COMMITMENT.

6 D. SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO FOSTER PARENTS AND
7 GROUP HOMES.
