# HOUSE BILL 2148

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-5242; RELATING TO MOTOR CARRIERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 14, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 28-5242, to read:

4 28-5242. Registration requirements; interstate or foreign  
5 commerce; enforcement; violations; classifications

6 A. A MOTOR CARRIER SHALL NOT OPERATE IN THIS STATE A MOTOR VEHICLE  
7 INVOLVED IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE OR REQUIRE OR ALLOW A DRIVER TO  
8 OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE INVOLVED IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE UNLESS THE  
9 MOTOR CARRIER IS REGISTERED PURSUANT TO 49 UNITED STATES CODE SECTIONS 13901  
10 AND 13902. A MOTOR CARRIER DOMICILED OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES SHALL HAVE  
11 PROOF OF THE REGISTRATION IN THE VEHICLE WHEN OPERATING IN THIS STATE.

12 B. A MOTOR CARRIER SHALL NOT OPERATE IN THIS STATE A MOTOR VEHICLE  
13 INVOLVED IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE OR REQUIRE OR ALLOW A DRIVER TO  
14 OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE INVOLVED IN INTERSTATE OR FOREIGN COMMERCE BEYOND THE  
15 SCOPE OF THE MOTOR CARRIER'S REGISTRATION ISSUED PURSUANT TO 49 UNITED STATES  
16 CODE SECTIONS 13901 AND 13902.

17 C. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION A OR B OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY  
18 OF A CLASS 2 MISDEMEANOR.

19 D. A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO SECTION 28-5204  
20 MAY PLACE A MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER AN OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER UNTIL EITHER THE  
21 CARGO IS REMOVED FROM THE VEHICLE OR THE OFFICER OBTAINS PROOF THAT THE MOTOR  
22 CARRIER IS REGISTERED PURSUANT TO 49 UNITED STATES CODE SECTIONS 13901 AND  
23 13902,

24 E. A MOTOR CARRIER SHALL NOT OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE OR ALLOW A DRIVER  
25 TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE SUBJECT TO AN OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER ISSUED PURSUANT  
26 TO THIS SECTION UNTIL THE REASON FOR THE OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER HAS BEEN  
27 REMEDIED. A MOTOR CARRIER OR DRIVER WHO VIOLATES THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY  
28 OF A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR.






