
CHAPTER 22

SENATE BILL 1262

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 12-108, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE SUPREME COURT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 12-108, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 12-108. Reports of decisions; publication; distribution;
5 publication cost

6 A. The supreme court may contract with the person who agrees to
7 publish and sell the report of decisions on terms most advantageous to the
8 state. ~~Such~~ THE contractor shall agree to publish ~~and deliver to the~~
9 ~~secretary of state~~ at the contract price the number of volumes as the
10 ~~secretary of state~~ SUPREME COURT may require.

11 ~~B. The secretary of state shall~~ AND TO deliver the volumes as follows:

12 1. To the Arizona state library, archives and public records the
13 number of copies necessary for its use and for exchange with the libraries
14 of other states and countries.

15 2. To the law library of the university of Arizona the number of
16 copies necessary for its use and for exchange with the law libraries of other
17 states and countries.

18 3. To the law library of Arizona state university the number of copies
19 necessary for its use and for exchange with the law libraries of other states
20 and countries.

21 4. To each supreme court justice, court of appeals judge, superior
22 court judge, the clerk of each court, ~~and~~ THE county attorney and the
23 reporter of decisions of the supreme court, one copy.

24 5. To the law library of each county, two copies.

25 6. To the department of law, thirty copies.

26 7. To the corporation commission, two copies.

27 8. To the industrial commission, seven copies.

28 9. To the department of public safety, two copies.

29 ~~C. B. Upon application and subject to legislative appropriation, the~~
30 ~~secretary of state shall deliver one volume each to All other agencies,~~
31 ~~boards, commissions and departments of the state. Upon a showing of need,~~
32 ~~the secretary of state may deliver additional volumes to a state agency,~~
33 ~~board, commission or department of the state. MAY REQUEST FROM THE~~
34 ~~CONTRACTOR ADDITIONAL VOLUMES, WHICH SHALL BE PUBLISHED AND DELIVERED AT THE~~
35 ~~CONTRACT PRICE TO BE PAID FOR BY THE REQUESTING ENTITY.~~

36 ~~D. C. Copies of reports~~ VOLUMES THAT ARE delivered to a person on
37 account of the office held by such THAT person remain the property of this
38 state and shall have stamped or written on them the name of the office and
39 shall be kept for the use of the office.

40 ~~E. D. SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS, the cost of publishing~~
41 ~~reports of decisions shall be paid from the appropriation for~~ TO the supreme
42 court. EACH ENTITY RECEIVING A VOLUME SHALL PAY THE COST OF DELIVERY.
