SENATE BILL 1117

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2000, CHAPTER 248, SECTIONS 1 AND 2; RELATING TO THE JOINT
LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON HUNGER.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Laws 2000, chapter 248, section 1 is amended to read:
3 Section 1. Joint legislative committee on hunger
4 A. The joint legislative committee on hunger is established consisting
5 of:
6 1. ~~Four~~ THREE members of the senate who are appointed by the president
7 of the senate, no more than two of whom are members of the same political
8 party. The president shall appoint one of these members to act as
9 cochairperson.
10 2. ~~Four~~ THREE members of the house of representatives who are
11 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, no more than two
12 of whom are members of the same political party. The speaker shall appoint
13 one of these members to act as cochairperson.
14 3. Two public members. One shall be appointed each by the president
15 of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives.
16 4. Five public members who are appointed by the governor.
17 5. Five advisory members who do not vote and who are not counted for
18 the purposes of determining a quorum. These members shall represent each of
19 the following departments and be appointed by the respective director:
20 (a) The department of economic security.
21 (b) The department of education.
22 (c) The Arizona department of agriculture.
23 (d) The state department of corrections.
24 (e) The department of health services.
25 B. Members who are appointed by the governor, the president of the
26 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives are appointed subject
27 to the following conditions:
28 1. The public members are not employees of this state.
29 2. At least five members of the committee are involved in providing
30 food assistance programs.
31 C. Public members are not eligible to receive compensation, but are
32 eligible for reimbursement of expenses pursuant to title 38, chapter 4,
33 article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes.
34 D. The legislature and the departments listed in subsection A,
35 paragraph 5 shall provide staff, administrative and technical support and
36 meeting space to the committee.
37 E. The committee shall:
38 1. Serve as a public forum for the purpose of discussing issues
39 regarding current and potential services and programs for food security
40 ELIMINATING HUNGER AND ITS CAUSES.
41 2. Review food security programs and services THAT ADDRESS HUNGER
42 NEEDS AND ITS CAUSES to ensure efficient and coordinated use of resources.
43 3. Submit a written report of its findings and recommendations to the
44 governor, the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of
45 representatives on or before December 1 of each year. The committee shall

1 submit copies of its report to the secretary of state and the director of the
2 department of library, archives and public records.

5 This act is repealed from and after December 31, 2003 2006.
