SENATE BILL 1159

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 44-1813, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT
OF SECURITIES PERSONNEL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 44-1813, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 44-1813. Employment of personnel; criminal records check
5 A. The director, with the approval of the commission, may employ from
6 time to time examiners, investigators who are commissioned peace officers,
7 clerical employees and other officers and employees necessary for the
8 administration of this chapter, and regulatory officers and employees who are
9 members of the state bar of Arizona who shall be paid at the same rate as the
10 rate established by the department of administration for attorneys, and who
11 shall perform the duties the director requires.

12 B. THE DIRECTOR MAY OBTAIN CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION
13 REGARDING APPLICANTS FOR EMPLOYMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING
14 PERSONNEL. BEFORE MAKING A FINAL OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT, THE DIRECTOR SHALL
15 REQUIRE THE PREFERRED APPLICANTS TO SUBMIT A FULL SET OF FINGERPRINTS. THE
16 DIRECTOR SHALL SUBMIT THE FINGERPRINTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR
17 THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A STATE AND FEDERAL CRIMINAL RECORDS CHECK PURSUANT
18 TO SECTION 41-1750 AND PUBLIC LAW 92-544. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
19 MAY EXCHANGE THIS FINGERPRINT DATA WITH THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION.

20 C. THE DIRECTOR SHALL NOT DISCLOSE INFORMATION OBTAINED PURSUANT TO
21 SUBSECTION B OF THIS SECTION EXCEPT TO THE DIRECTOR'S OR THE COMMISSION'S
22 STAFF SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE DIRECTOR'S EMPLOYMENT OF THE APPLICANT.
