CHAPTER 55

HOUSE BILL 2160

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 20-1382, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING LAWS 1997,
CHAPTER 251, SECTION 36; RELATING TO HEALTH CARE INSURERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 20-1382, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 20-1382. Health care insurers; reporting requirements

5 A. ~~Beginning on March 1, 1998 and each March 1 thereafter~~ ON OR BEFORE
6 MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, each health care insurer shall ~~issue~~ SUBMIT TO THE
7 DIRECTOR a WRITTEN report ~~to the director that specifies~~ THAT CONTAINS THE
8 FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

9 1. The number of eligible individuals covered by policies THAT WERE
10 written by that health care insurer in the individual market during the
11 previous calendar year. ~~the report shall also include~~

12 2. The number of individuals covered by policies THAT WERE issued
13 other than to eligible individuals during the previous calendar year. and

14 3. The earned premium for each category of individual policy for the
15 previous calendar year.

16 4. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS COVERED BY POLICIES THAT
17 WERE ISSUED BY THE HEALTH CARE INSURER AS OF THE END OF THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR
18 YEAR.

19 B. Each health care insurer shall submit the following information to
20 the department, if applicable, to demonstrate compliance with sections
21 20-1379, 20-1380 and 20-1381:

22 1. The health care insurer's name and address.

23 2. The identification, form number and summary of all products that
24 the health care insurer offers in the individual market.

25 3. If the health care insurer elects the option prescribed in section
26 20-1379, subsection C, paragraph 2, subdivision (a) the data on premium
27 volumes of all policy forms that the health care insurer offers in the
28 individual market and the number of individuals who are covered under each
29 form during the preceding calendar year.

30 4. If the health care insurer elects the option prescribed in section
31 20-1379, subsection C, paragraph 2, subdivision (b) the data, assumptions and
32 methods used to calculate the actuarial values of the two representative
33 policy forms.

34 5. An explanation of how the health care insurer is complying with
35 sections 20-1379, 20-1380 and 20-1381.

36 6. A list of all products, including all marketing material, that the
37 health care insurer is making or will make available to eligible individuals
38 and an explanation of how the health care insurer will inform individuals of
39 these policy forms.

40 7. A description of the risk spreading and financial subsidization
41 mechanism.

42 C. ~~For policy forms being marketed from and after June 30, 1997, each~~
43 ~~health care insurer shall submit the information described in subsection B~~
44 ~~of this section to the department by September 1, 1997. For all other policy~~

1 forms; The health care insurer shall submit the information described in
2 subsection B of this section to the department by March 1 of each year.

3 D. IF ALL OR PART OF THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION B,
4 PARAGRAPH 5, 6 OR 7 OF THIS SECTION HAS NOT CHANGED SINCE THE HEALTH CARE
5 INSURER'S LAST PREVIOUS SUBMISSION, INSTEAD OF REFILING THE INFORMATION THE
6 HEALTH CARE INSURER MAY INDICATE THE INFORMATION THAT HAS NOT CHANGED.
