CHAPTER 91

SENATE BILL 1008

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND AND MAKING A
NUCLEAR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND ASSESSMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; purpose

3 Pursuant to sections 26-306.01 and 26-306.02, Arizona Revised Statutes,
4 the sum of \$1,012,992 in fiscal year 2003-2004 and the sum of \$1,036,085 in
5 fiscal year 2004-2005 is appropriated from the state general fund to the
6 nuclear emergency management fund for the following agencies:

7 1. For use by the division of emergency management of the department
8 of emergency and military affairs as provided in section 26-306.02, Arizona
9 Revised Statutes, the lump sum of \$286,017 and 4.5 full-time equivalent
10 positions in fiscal year 2003-2004 and \$294,306 and 4.5 full-time equivalent
11 positions in fiscal year 2004-2005.

12 2. For use by the radiation regulatory agency for programs relating
13 to off-site nuclear emergency response plans, the lump sum of \$451,600 and
14 4 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2003-2004 and \$451,600 and
15 4 full-time equivalent positions in fiscal year 2004-2005.

16 3. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the
17 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of
18 Maricopa County assigned responsibilities under the off-site nuclear
19 emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$243,824 in fiscal year 2003-2004
20 and \$258,628 in fiscal year 2004-2005.

21 4. For disbursement by the division of emergency management of the
22 department of emergency and military affairs to departments and agencies of
23 the town of Buckeye assigned responsibilities under the off-site nuclear
24 emergency response plan, the lump sum of \$31,551 in fiscal year 2003-2004 and
25 \$31,551 in fiscal year 2004-2005.

26 Sec. 2. Assessment; purpose

27 Pursuant to section 26-306.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, the sum of
28 \$1,012,992 in fiscal year 2003-2004 and \$1,036,085 in fiscal year 2004-2005,
29 plus any applicable interest, is assessed against each consortium of public
30 service corporations and municipal corporations engaged in constructing or
31 operating a commercial nuclear generating station in this state.

32 Sec. 3. Emergency

33 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
34 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
35 law.
