# HOUSE BILL 2005

AN ACT

MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE INDEPENDENT REDISTRICTING  
COMMISSION FOR EXPENSES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Supplemental appropriation; purpose; exemption

3 A. In addition to the monies authorized for payment of expenses of the  
4 independent redistricting commission pursuant to article IV, part 2, section  
5 1, Constitution of Arizona, the sum of \$1,703,000 is appropriated from the  
6 state general fund in fiscal year 2003-2004 to the independent redistricting  
7 commission for fees, costs and any other operating expenses incurred pursuant  
8 to article IV, part 2, section 1, Constitution of Arizona.

9 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
10 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
11 lapsing, except that all monies remaining unexpended and unencumbered after  
12 payment of fees, costs and expenses of the commission revert to the state  
13 general fund.
