4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3014.01, to read:

7 1, 2014
8 A. THE ARIZONA STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2014.
9 B. TITLE 32, CHAPTER 18 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2015.
10 Sec. 3. Purpose
11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 the legislature continues the Arizona state board of pharmacy to promote the
13 safe and professional practice of pharmacy in this state.
14 Sec. 4. Retroactivity
15 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
16 2004.
