HOUSE BILL 2099

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 9-967, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 9-967, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 9-967. Pension for volunteer fire fighter

5 A. A person duly appointed and having served either as a member of a
6 legally organized fire district or as a member of a fire department of any
7 incorporated city or town for twenty-five years or more, or who has reached
8 sixty years of age, and served twenty years or more, shall be paid a monthly
9 pension not to exceed two FOUR hundred dollars per month based on the
10 benefits available to members of that fire department or district as
11 determined by the board of trustees. The pension shall be paid from the fire
12 fighters' relief and pension fund of his fire district or fire
13 department. Such pension if paid may be increased or decreased in amount,
14 or discontinued at the discretion of the board of trustees.

15 B. If the funds provided in the volunteer fire fighters' relief and
16 pension fund are insufficient to pay fully the pensions authorized pursuant
17 to this section, the fund shall be prorated among those entitled thereto.
