CHAPTER 280

SENATE BILL 1411

AN ACT

MAKING FUNDING TRANSFERS; PROVIDING FOR WATER AND RECREATIONAL PROTECTION.

(TEXT OF BILL, BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. WQARF transfer from corporate income tax; suspension

3 Notwithstanding section 49-282, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
4 or any other law, the state treasurer shall transfer only \$10,000,000 from
5 the corporate income tax collected pursuant to title 43, chapter 11, article
6 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, to the water quality assurance revolving fund
7 in fiscal year 2004-2005. These monies are in addition to revenues from
8 sources specified in section 49-282, subsection A, paragraphs 2 through 11
9 and 13, Arizona Revised Statutes. No monies from the transaction privilege
10 and severance tax clearing account established pursuant to section 42-5029,
11 subsection D, paragraph 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, shall be deposited in
12 the water quality assurance revolving fund in fiscal year 2004-2005.

13 Sec. 2. Underground storage tank assurance account; transfer of
14 monies; uses

15 Notwithstanding any other law, the administrative cap established in
16 section 49-1051, subsection B, paragraphs 2 and 3, Arizona Revised Statutes,
17 is suspended for fiscal year 2004-2005 and the department of environmental
18 quality may transfer \$6,930,900 from the assurance account of the underground
19 storage tank revolving fund for administrative costs, including the
20 integration of the assurance account of the underground storage tank
21 revolving fund and underground storage tank databases into a single database,
22 the underground storage tank leak prevention program and funding for the used
23 oil program.

24 Sec. 3. Arizona water protection fund; use

25 Notwithstanding section 45-2112, subsection B, Arizona Revised
26 Statutes, the annual appropriation from the state general fund to the Arizona
27 water protection fund for fiscal year 2004-2005 shall be as specified in the
28 general appropriations act.

29 Sec. 4. Department of water resources; operating expenses; use
30 of monies from augmentation and conservation
31 assistance fund and dam repair fund

32 Notwithstanding title 45, chapter 2, article 11, Arizona Revised
33 Statutes, and title 45, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, the director of
34 water resources may expend up to a total of \$1,551,600 of the unencumbered
35 monies in the augmentation and conservation assistance fund established
36 pursuant to section 45-615, paragraph 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, and the
37 dam repair fund established by section 45-1212.01, Arizona Revised Statutes,
38 for operating expenses of the department of water resources during fiscal
39 year 2004-2005.

40 Sec. 5. Off-highway vehicle recreation fund; use

41 Notwithstanding section 28-1176, Arizona Revised Statutes, the Arizona
42 state parks board may spend up to \$692,100 from the Arizona state parks board
43 portion of the off-highway vehicle fund in fiscal year 2004-2005 for parks
44 board operating expenses.

1 Sec. 6. State parks enhancement fund; use

2 Notwithstanding section 41-511.11, Arizona Revised Statutes, or any
3 other law, all monies, except those necessary for the lease-purchase payments
4 for the Tonto Natural Bridge State Park, are available for the operating of
5 state parks in fiscal year 2004-2005 as appropriated by the legislature in
6 the general appropriations act.
