# SENATE BILL 1417

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FEES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Arizona historical society; fees

3 Notwithstanding section 41-823, Arizona Revised Statutes, or any other  
4 law, the Arizona historical society may charge a fee for services during  
5 fiscal year 2004-2005.

6 Sec. 2. Department of insurance; fee and assessment adjustment  
7 suspension

8 Notwithstanding section 20-167, subsection F, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
9 and section 20-466, subsection J, Arizona Revised Statutes, the director of  
10 insurance shall not revise fees or assessments in fiscal year 2004-2005 for  
11 the purposes of meeting the requirement to recover at least ninety-five per  
12 cent but not more than one hundred ten per cent of the department of  
13 insurance's appropriated budget.

14 Sec. 3. State real estate department; fee adjustment;  
15 suspension

16 Notwithstanding section 32-2103, subsection B, Arizona Revised  
17 Statutes, the state real estate commissioner shall not revise fees in fiscal  
18 year 2004-2005 for the purposes of meeting the requirement to recover at  
19 least ninety-five per cent but not more than one hundred ten per cent of the  
20 state real estate department's appropriated budget.
