CHAPTER 287

SENATE BILL 1418

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 41-129, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO ELECTION SYSTEMS FUNDING.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 41-129, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-129. Election systems improvement fund; purpose

5 A. The election systems improvement fund is established in the office
6 of the secretary of state. The fund shall consist of monies received from
7 the United States government, matching monies from state, county or local
8 governments, legislative appropriations, gifts, grants and donations.

9 B. The secretary of state shall administer the fund. Any monies
10 deposited into the fund in fiscal years 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 are
11 appropriated to the secretary of state and are exempt from the provisions of
12 section 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations. TO THE EXTENT
13 PERMITTED BY FEDERAL LAW, monies deposited in the fund, OTHER THAN STATE
14 GENERAL FUND MONIES, DEPOSITED each subsequent fiscal year are subject to
15 legislative appropriation and such appropriations are subject to the lapsing
16 provisions of section 35-190. STATE GENERAL FUND MONIES APPROPRIATED TO THE
17 FUND BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 ARE AVAILABLE FOR USE BY THE
18 SECRETARY OF STATE WITHOUT FURTHER APPROPRIATION. Monies in the fund do not
19 revert to the state general fund or any other funding source at the end of
20 the fiscal year. The state treasurer shall invest and divest monies in the
21 fund as provided by section 35-313, and monies earned from investment shall
22 be credited to the fund.

23 C. Within thirty days after any expenditure of monies from the fund,
24 the secretary of state shall submit to the joint legislative budget committee
25 a summary of the total expenditure plan for the fund.

26 D. Monies in the fund shall be used to implement the provisions of the
27 help America vote act of 2002 (P.L. 107-252).
