# HOUSE BILL 2462

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 28-2236 AND 28-2239, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO  
COMMERCIAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-2236, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 28-2236. Interstate commercial fleet registration;  
5 identification; fee; registration card

6 A. On payment of the appropriate fees for a proportional registration  
7 application submitted pursuant to this article, the director shall register  
8 the vehicles described and identified in the application and may SHALL issue  
9 a distinctive PERMANENT VALIDATING sticker for each motor vehicle described  
10 in the application. In addition, the director shall charge a fee of three  
11 dollars for each additional proportionally registered vehicle and shall  
12 determine whether to issue a sticker.

13 B. The department shall issue a registration card for each  
14 proportionally registered vehicle that bears on its face the number of the  
15 license or distinctive THE PERMANENT VALIDATING sticker issued for the  
16 proportionally registered vehicle and other information from the application  
17 for proportional registration as the director determines is appropriate for  
18 identifying the vehicle. The registration card, OR A FACSIMILE OF THE  
19 REGISTRATION CARD, shall be carried in the vehicle at all times. If it is  
20 a combination of vehicles, the registration card shall be carried in the  
21 vehicle supplying the motive power.

22 C. Proportionally registered interstate fleet vehicles that are  
23 registered and identified pursuant to this article and chapter 15, article  
24 3 of this title are fully licensed and registered in this state for any type  
25 of movement or operation.

26 Sec. 2. Section 28-2239, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:  
27 28-2239. Temporary proportional registrations; fee

28 A. The department may sell temporary proportional registrations to  
29 motor carriers ~~with existing fleets~~ that are registered REGISTERING under  
30 this article. Motor carriers may use temporary proportional registrations  
31 for vehicles that are added to an existing fleet or in lieu of lost  
32 registrations pending receipt of permanent or replacement registrations.

33 B. The cost of a temporary proportional registration is one dollar,  
34 and the registration is valid for thirty NINETY days.
