DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF APRIL AS FINANCIAL LITERACY FOR YOUTH MONTH IN ARIZONA.

1 Whereas, personal financial education is essential for ensuring that
2 the youth of Arizona are prepared to manage money, investments and credit
3 wisely and responsibly; and

4 Whereas, acquisition of financial literacy skills by Arizona's youth
5 will improve the quality of their lives as adults, will provide them with
6 skills for success, will contribute to positive changes for the communities
7 in which they live and work and will benefit the economy of this state; and

8 Whereas, the goal of Financial Literacy for Youth Month is to increase
9 public and educator awareness of the need to improve the personal and
10 financial literacy of Arizona's young people; and

11 Whereas, this endeavor is worthy of support and cooperation for the
12 benefit of the citizens and consumers of the State of Arizona to protect the
13 financial future of the state's youth.

14 Therefore

15 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
16 Representatives concurring:

17 That the Legislature proclaims April as Financial Literacy for Youth
18 Month in Arizona and encourages parents and educators to participate in this
19 observance with appropriate activities and exercises.
