CHAPTER 6

HOUSE BILL 2387

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR EMPLOYEES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; purpose; payment date; report

3 A. The sum of \$7,500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
4 in fiscal year 2004-2005 to the state department of corrections for costs
5 related to employee compensatory time payouts.

6 B. The sum of \$10,000,000 is appropriated from the risk management
7 fund in fiscal year 2004-2005 and \$2,499,100 from the state general fund in
8 fiscal year 2004-2005 to the department of administration to pay the on-call
9 pay settlement agreements. Once claims are fully settled and paid, amounts
10 appropriated in accordance with this subsection that are not required to pay
11 on-call claims shall revert to the state general fund.

12 C. The state department of corrections shall forward all claim
13 information to the department of administration within thirty days after the
14 effective date of this act. The department of administration shall pay all
15 claims within fifteen days after receipt of the claims from the state
16 department of corrections.

17 D. The state department of corrections shall report to the joint
18 legislative budget committee on the status of the claims and payment of the
19 claims for the employee overtime pay and the on-call pay settlements on or
20 before May 1, 2005.

21 Sec. 2. Interest charges; prohibition

22 Within sixty days after the effective date of this act, the state
23 department of corrections and the department of administration shall not pay
24 any further monies for interest charges relating to the on-call pay
25 settlement agreements.

26 Sec. 3. Emergency

27 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
28 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
29 law.


