HOUSE BILL 2337

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 38, ARTICLE 29, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 13-4402.01; RELATING TO CRIME VICTIMS' RIGHTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 38, article 29, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 13-4402.01, to read:

4 13-4402.01 Victims' rights; dismissed counts

5 A. IF AN OFFENSE AGAINST A VICTIM HAS BEEN CHARGED BUT THE PROSECUTION
6 ON THE COUNT OR COUNTS INVOLVING THE VICTIM HAS BEEN OR IS BEING DISMISSED AS
7 THE RESULT OF A PLEA AGREEMENT IN WHICH THE DEFENDANT IS PLEADING TO OR PLED
8 TO OTHER CHARGES, THE VICTIM OF THE OFFENSES INVOLVED IN THE DISMISSED COUNT
9 OR COUNTS, ON REQUEST, MAY EXERCISE ALL THE RIGHTS OF A CRIME VICTIM
10 THROUGHOUT THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE PROCESS AS THOUGH THE COUNT OR COUNTS
11 INVOLVING THE PERSON HAD NOT BEEN DISMISSED

12 B. AS TO EACH COUNT THAT IS DISMISSED, THE PROSECUTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE
13 PROBATION DEPARTMENT IF THE VICTIM REQUESTED THE VICTIM'S RIGHTS PURSUANT TO
14 THIS CHAPTER.

15 C. FOR EACH VICTIM WHO IS INVOLVED IN THE DISMISSED COUNT OR COUNTS
16 AND WHO REQUESTED THE VICTIM'S RIGHTS, THE PROSECUTOR SHALL FORWARD TO THE
17 PROBATION DEPARTMENT INFORMATION WITHIN THE PROSECUTOR'S POSSESSION THAT
18 WOULD ENABLE THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT TO CARRY OUT ITS DUTIES AS PRESCRIBED
19 BY THIS CHAPTER.

20 Sec. 2. Effective date

21 This act is effective from and after December 31, 2005.




