CHAPTER 17

HOUSE BILL 2363

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 11-424.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COUNTY
PRECINCT OFFICER SALARIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 11-424.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 11-424.01. Salaries of precinct officers other than justices of
5 the peace; definition

6 A. At the regular June meeting of the several boards of supervisors
7 preceding a general election, the boards shall fix the salaries of all
8 precinct officers, other than justices of the peace, for those officers to be
9 elected for the four-year period commencing on the first day of the following
10 January.

11 B. In precincts with an average of no more than one hundred total
12 civil cases on file over the previous four years, the constables shall
13 receive annual salaries of not more than fifteen thousand dollars.

14 C. In precincts with an average of more than one hundred total civil
15 cases on file over the previous four years, the constables shall be paid as
16 follows:

17 1. IN PRECINCTS WITH FEWER THAN TEN THOUSAND REGISTERED VOTERS, ANNUAL
18 SALARIES OF NOT MORE THAN TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.

19 ~~1.~~ 2. In precincts with ~~more than~~ ten thousand OR MORE registered
20 voters but fewer than twelve thousand registered voters, annual salaries of
21 not less than ~~twenty-three thousand five hundred fifty~~ TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND
22 FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN nor more than ~~twenty-eight thousand two hundred~~
23 ~~sixty~~ THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED dollars.

24 ~~2.~~ 3. In precincts with twelve thousand OR MORE registered voters but
25 fewer than sixteen thousand registered voters, annual salaries of not less
26 than ~~twenty-eight thousand eight hundred eighty~~ THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE
27 HUNDRED nor more than ~~thirty-four thousand six hundred sixty~~ FORTY-FIVE
28 THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE dollars.

29 ~~3.~~ 4. In precincts with sixteen thousand or more registered voters,
30 annual salaries of not less than forty-eight thousand two hundred ninety-four
31 nor more than fifty-five thousand six hundred fifty-four dollars.

32 D. The board of supervisors shall determine, subject to subsections B
33 and C, the salary of a constable appointed to fill a vacancy caused otherwise
34 than by expiration of term. Nothing in this subsection shall be deemed to
35 authorize an increase or decrease in the salary during the term of office of
36 a constable appointed to fill a vacancy.

37 E. As used in this section, "registered voter" means a qualified
38 elector of a precinct who is registered on June 1 of each year.
