# HOUSE BILL 2221

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 35, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 35-196.04; RELATING TO PUBLIC FUNDING FOR HUMAN CLONING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 35, chapter 1, article 5, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 35-196.04, to read:

4 35-196.04. Use of public monies for human cloning; prohibition;  
5 definition

6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, TAX MONIES OF THIS STATE OR ANY  
7 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, FEDERAL MONIES PASSING THROUGH THE STATE  
8 TREASURY OR THE TREASURY OF ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE OR ANY  
9 OTHER PUBLIC MONIES SHALL NOT BE USED BY ANY PERSON OR ENTITY, INCLUDING ANY  
10 STATE FUNDED INSTITUTION OR FACILITY, FOR HUMAN SOMATIC CELL NUCLEAR  
11 TRANSFER, COMMONLY KNOWN AS HUMAN CLONING.

12 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT RESTRICT AREAS OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH THAT  
13 ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITED BY THIS SECTION, INCLUDING RESEARCH IN THE  
14 USE OF NUCLEAR TRANSFER OR OTHER CLONING TECHNIQUES TO PRODUCE MOLECULES,  
15 DEOXYRIBONUCLEIC ACID, CELLS OTHER THAN HUMAN EMBRYOS, TISSUES, ORGANS,  
16 PLANTS OR ANIMALS OTHER THAN HUMANS.

17 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "HUMAN SOMATIC CELL NUCLEAR  
18 TRANSFER" MEANS HUMAN ASEXUAL REPRODUCTION THAT IS ACCOMPLISHED BY  
19 INTRODUCING THE GENETIC MATERIAL FROM ONE OR MORE HUMAN SOMATIC CELLS INTO A  
20 FERTILIZED OR UNFERTILIZED OOCYTE WHOSE NUCLEAR MATERIAL HAS BEEN REMOVED OR  
21 INACTIVATED SO AS TO PRODUCE AN ORGANISM, AT ANY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT, THAT  
22 IS GENETICALLY VIRTUALLY IDENTICAL TO AN EXISTING OR PREVIOUSLY EXISTING  
23 HUMAN ORGANISM.






