CHAPTER 207

SENATE BILL 1360

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE COMMITTEE.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Retiree health insurance committee; membership;
3 duties; report

4 A. The retiree health insurance committee is established consisting of
5 the following members:

6 1. Three members of the house of representatives who are appointed by
7 the speaker of the house of representatives, not more than two of whom are
8 members of the same political party. The speaker of the house of
9 representatives shall appoint one of these members to serve as cochairperson
10 of the committee.

11 2. Three members of the senate who are appointed by the president of
12 the senate, not more than two of whom are members of the same political
13 party. The president of the senate shall appoint one of these members to
14 serve as cochairperson of the committee.

15 3. One member who is appointed by the governor.

16 4. Two members of the public who are appointed jointly by the speaker
17 of the house of representatives and the president of the senate.

18 B. Committee members are not eligible to receive compensation, but are
19 eligible for reimbursement of expenses pursuant to title 38, chapter 4,
20 article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes.

21 C. The committee shall review and evaluate the retiree health
22 insurance options proposed by the private entity pursuant to the legislative
23 council study on retiree health insurance report that was submitted pursuant
24 to Laws 2004, chapter 325, section 8. The committee shall recommend one of
25 these options to the legislature and the governor.

26 D. The committee may use the services of legislative staff as
27 required.

28 E. On or before December 31, 2005, the committee shall submit a
29 written report of its recommendations to the speaker of the house of
30 representatives, the president of the senate and the governor. The committee
31 shall provide a copy of the report to the secretary of state and the director
32 of the Arizona state library, archives and public records.

33 Sec. 2. Delayed repeal

34 Section 1 of this act, relating to the retiree health insurance
35 committee, is repealed from and after September 30, 2006.
