CHAPTER 229

HOUSE BILL 2459

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 32-1685, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE BOARD OF DISPENSING OPTICIANS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-1685, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

5 A. The board shall establish nonrefundable fees that do not exceed the
6 following:

7 1. Filing an application for a dispensing optician license, ~~one~~ TWO
8 hundred dollars.

9 2. Issuing an original dispensing optician license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred
10 dollars.

11 3. Renewing a dispensing optician license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred dollars.

12 4. Late renewal of a dispensing optician license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred
13 dollars.

14 5. Name change and issuance of a duplicate dispensing optician
15 license, one hundred dollars.

16 6. Reinstatement of a dispensing optician license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred
17 dollars.

18 7. Filing an application for an optical establishment license, ~~one~~ TWO
19 hundred dollars.

20 8. Issuing an original optical establishment license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred
21 dollars.

22 9. Renewing an optical establishment license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred dollars.

23 10. Late renewal of an optical establishment license, ~~one~~ TWO hundred
24 dollars.

25 11. Name or location change and issuance of a duplicate optical
26 establishment license, one hundred dollars.

27 B. The board may charge additional fees for services that the board
28 deems are necessary to carry out this chapter and board rules. These fees
29 shall not exceed the costs of rendering the services.

30 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; two-thirds vote

31 Pursuant to article IX, section 22, Constitution of Arizona, this act
32 is effective only on the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the
33 members of each house of the legislature and is effective immediately on the
34 signature of the governor or, if the governor vetoes this act, on the
35 subsequent affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of each
36 house of the legislature.
