1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Section 41-3005.06, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.

4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3015.01, to read:

6 41-3015.01. Solar energy advisory council; termination July 1,
7 2015

8 A. THE SOLAR ENERGY ADVISORY COUNCIL TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2015.

9 B. SECTION 41-1510 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2016.

10 Sec. 3. Purpose


11 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 the legislature continues the solar energy advisory council to give advice on
13 matters relating to solar energy.

14 Sec. 4. Retroactivity

15 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to July 1,
16 2005.
