SENATE BILL 1201

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 36-1601, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 36-1601, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 36-1601. Definitions

5 In this article, unless the context otherwise requires:

6 1. "Fireworks":

7 (a) Means any combustible or explosive composition, substance or
8 combination of substances, or any article prepared for the purpose of
9 producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration
10 or detonation, and toy cannons in which explosives are used, the type of
11 balloon which requires fire underneath to propel it, firecrackers, torpedoes,
12 skyrockets, roman candles, daygo bombs, sparklers or other fireworks of like
13 construction, fireworks containing any explosive or combustible compound, and
14 any tablet or other device containing an explosive substance. ~~The term~~
15 "fireworks"

16 (b) Does not include:

17 (i) Toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns or other devices in which paper
18 caps containing not more than twenty-five hundredths grains of explosive
19 compound are used if constructed so that the hand cannot come in contact with
20 the cap when in place for the explosion. ~~or~~

21 (ii) Toy pistol paper caps which THAT contain less than
22 twenty-hundredths grains of explosive mixture, or fixed ammunition or primers
23 therefor.

24 (iii) FEDERALLY DEREGULATED NOVELTY ITEMS KNOWN AS SNAPPERS, SNAP
25 CAPS, PARTY POPPERS OR GLOW WORMS THAT CONTAIN LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE
26 HUNDREDTHS GRAINS OF EXPLOSIVE COMPOUND.

27 2. "Governing body" means board of supervisors of a county as to the
28 area within the county but without the corporate limits of an incorporated
29 city or town, and means governing body of an incorporated city or town as to
30 the area within its corporate limits.

31 3. "Person" includes individual, partnership, firm or corporation.
