AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 31, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-3118; RELATING TO WEAPONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 31, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding section 13-3118, to read:
4 13-3118. Possession or storage of firearms; restrictions
5 prohibited; exceptions
6 A. EXCEPT FOR THE LEGISLATURE, THIS STATE AND ANY AGENCY OR POLITICAL
7 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE SHALL NOT ENACT OR IMPLEMENT ANY LAW, RULE OR
8 ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE POSSESSION OR STORAGE OF FIREARMS OTHER THAN AS
9 PROVIDED IN STATUTE.
10 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT:
11 1. A STATE, COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT, LAW ENFORCEMENT
12 AGENCY OR PROSECUTORIAL AGENCY FROM PROHIBITING A DEADLY WEAPON PURSUANT TO
13 SECTION 13-3102, SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPH 10.
14 2. A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE FROM ENACTING ANY RULE OR
15 ORDINANCE REQUIRING A BUSINESS THAT OBTAINS A SECONDHAND FIREARM BY PURCHASE,
16 TRADE OR CONSIGNMENT TO RETAIN THE FIREARM FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN TEN
17 DAYS AT ITS PLACE OF BUSINESS OR ANOTHER STORAGE LOCATION THAT IS APPROVED BY
18 THE APPLICABLE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
