SENATE BILL 1355

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR AUTISM RESEARCH.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; autism research; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$7,100,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
4 in fiscal year 2006-2007 to the department of health services for
5 distribution to a nonprofit medical research foundation in this state that
6 specializes in biotechnology and that collaborates with universities,
7 hospitals, biotechnology and health science research centers and other public
8 and private biotechnology businesses in this state. The monies shall only be
9 expended for autism research, and the department of health services shall not
10 expend any of the monies for administration of the appropriation.

11 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
13 lapsing of appropriations through June 30, 2008.
