1           Whereas, Fantasy Island is a popular mountain biking trail system and  
2 proposed park located in southeast Tucson; and

3           Whereas, Fantasy Island is an important asset that greatly adds to the  
4 quality of life in the Tucson community for persons of all ages by providing  
5 much needed open space and a convenient venue for outdoor exercise; and

6           Whereas, Fantasy Island provides a great economic benefit to the  
7 community and state by attracting mountain bike riders from around the world,  
8 thus serving as a key tourist destination in southern Arizona; and

9           Whereas, Fantasy Island is currently threatened by possible real estate  
10 development, which could destroy this irreplaceable asset.

12 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona, the  
13 Senate concurring:

14           That the members of the Legislature express their strong support for  
15 the community efforts to protect and save Fantasy Island.
