Today I vetoed Senate Bill 1479, relating to land use regulations. I did so for the same reasons that I vetoed Senate Bill 1477 on May 9, 2005. The conversations I called for last year among cities, builders, realtors and affordable housing advocates are on-going and have yet to result in a consensus for dealing with this issue on a statewide basis and in a manner that takes into account the best interest of all Arizonans. As a result, consideration of this bill remains premature.


