# **HOUSE BILL 2476**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE RETROACTIVE EFFECT OF LAWS 2006, CHAPTER 323; RELATING TO  
PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Retroactive application of property tax exemption  
3 relating to permanent improvements constructed on  
4 land owned by agricultural improvement districts

5 Section 42-11102, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by Laws 2006,  
6 chapter 323, section 1, is effective retroactively to September 18, 2003.

7 Sec. 2. Intent

8 It is the intent of the legislature that the removal of section  
9 42-11102, subsection D, Arizona Revised Statutes, pursuant to Laws 2006,  
10 chapter 323 be effective retroactively to the date that subsection was  
11 originally enacted into law, thus causing the text of that subsection to have  
12 no legal effect for any time period.

13 Sec. 3. Emergency

14 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
15 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
16 law.
