# **HOUSE BILL 2185**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 23-1067, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 23-1067, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 23-1067. Commutation of compensation to lump sum payment

5 A. The commission may allow commutation of the compensation awarded  
6 pursuant to section 23-1044, subsection B to a lump sum payment of not to  
7 exceed twenty-five thousand dollars, with or without the consent of the  
8 carrier liable for the commutation, under such rules, regulations and system  
9 of computation as it devises for obtaining the present value of the  
10 compensation.

11 B. The commission may allow commutation of compensation pursuant to  
12 section 23-1044, subsection C, and section 23-1045, subsections B, C and D,  
13 to a lump sum of not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for commutation  
14 requests made before July 1, 1987, and fifty thousand dollars for commutation  
15 requests made from and after June 30, 1987 BUT BEFORE JULY 1, 2007 AND ONE  
16 HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR COMMUTATION REQUESTS MADE FROM AND AFTER  
17 JUNE 30, 2007, with the consent of the carrier liable to pay the claim, under  
18 such rules, regulations and system of computation as it devises for obtaining  
19 the present value of the compensation.

20 Sec. 2. Retroactivity

21 Section 23-1067, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act,  
22 applies retroactively to from and after June 30, 2007.
